# PHASE 1: Must meet criteria in 2 out of the 3 tests to proceed to Phase II

### NAGLIERI NONVERBAL ABILITY TEST (NNAT)

- Brief, culture-fair nonverbal measure of school ability
- Assesses ability without requiring the student to read, write, or speak
- Students must rely on reasoning and problem-solving skills, not on verbal skills
- Measures general ability; scores are predictive of academic success
- Students must examine the relationships among the parts of a design and determine the correct response on the basis of information inherent in the item
- Four clusters measuring general ability are assessed
  - o Pattern Completion
  - o Reasoning by Analogy
  - o Serial Reasoning
  - o Spatial Reasoning
