- 7. Sent to principal's office for misconduct more than once (You will get ONE warning.)

- 9. Fighting at school
- 10.Leaving school without notifying someone in authority
- 11. Any conduct unbecoming of a Mission CISD academic competitor (cursing, harassing of coaches and/or teammates, destruction of property, etc.)
- 12. Smoking, drinking alcoholic beverages, marijuana, or drugs, will get you out of the academic competition program.
